Include a caption list, which should include the image number, a caption, any needed credit lines, and a placement instruction typed directly into the manuscript itself: <01 Here>, for example. Be sure to consult your editor about any illustration questions you have prior to delivery.

*Note that contributor releases *must* state that you, the editor, own the essays, or have exclusive rights to them, and the contributor does not expect remuneration from the publisher. You may use the enclosed, or use this wording in a release of your own.
