Ruth Hawthorn and John Miller's anthology *Animals in Detective Fiction* is part of the Palgrave Studies in Animals and Literature series, which adds to the body of research in a wide variety of academic disciplines examining ethical and philosophical questions related to human vs. non-human animal relationships. The editors, both senior lecturers at English universities, have gathered contributions from an international slate of scholars from the United Kingdom, the United States, Sweden, and Germany. The 13 essays address an eclectic assortment of themes, authors, and works, and are divided into four focus-related groups:

## Ontologies, Ethics, Politics, and Forms, framed by an introduction by the editors and a concluding index.
